

Wycombe Wanderers Website Match Report

Wanderers succumbed to defeat at Exeter City on Boxing Day at St James' Park, with Sonny Cox netting a second-half winner for the Grecians before Luke Leahy's late penalty was saved.

Neither side created much in front of goal in the first period but the hosts stepped on the gas after the break and made the breakthrough thanks to Cox's close-range finish, with Max Stryjek also making a series of fine saves to keep his side in the game.

Wycombe laid siege to the City box late on, seeing Kieran Sadlier have a goal disallowed for handball and Dale Taylor hit the crossbar, before referee Charles Breakspear pointed to the spot for an alleged foul on Taylor in stoppage time, only for keeper Viljami Sinisalo to thwart Leahy's spot-kick.

The Blues return to action for the final time in 2023 at Leyton Orient on Friday night.
